Tim Roettgen's Biography:

Mr. Roettgen has been involved in marching arts for over 32 years. His career began as the rifle instructor at Helias Catholic High School in 1988. During college, he was a member of the Madison Scouts Color Guard in 1990 and 1991. In the winter of 1993, Mr. Roettgen was the weapons instructor for the Missouri State University Pride Winter Guard. After college, Mr. Roettgen became the Color Guard Caption Head at Jefferson City High School Marching Jay Band. During the winter of 1995, he became the Chief Judge of the Mid Continent Color Guard Association, the Winter Guard circuit for the central Midwest in the United States. In 1998, Mr. Roettgen became the show designer for the Camdenton High School Varsity Winter. He has spent the last 20 years as the Color Coordinator for Camdenton High School Marching Band. Since beginning his career in the marching arts, his group's have performed at a variety of local contest as well as the Peach Bowl in Atlanta, GA, the Freedom Bowl in Los Angeles, CA, several Bands of America Regional Championships, Walt Disney's Magic Kingdom and Epcot, Winter Guard International Regionals and Championships, the King Kamahamaha Parade in Honolulu, HI, and the Bands of America Grand National Championships. Mr. Roettgen has been a judge and clinician at a variety of levels in the activity.



Mr. Roettgen earned a Bachelor's of Science degree in English Education from Lincoln University in Jefferson City, MO. He also has a Master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction from the University of Missouri - Columbia, and he has a Master's degree in School Counseling from Lincoln University. Mr. Roettgen was an English teacher for eleven years, teaching eleventh grade Honors English and Inclusion English. He was voted Secondary Teacher of the Year for the Camdenton School District in 2008. Mr. Roettgen is currently a School Counselor at the high school.
